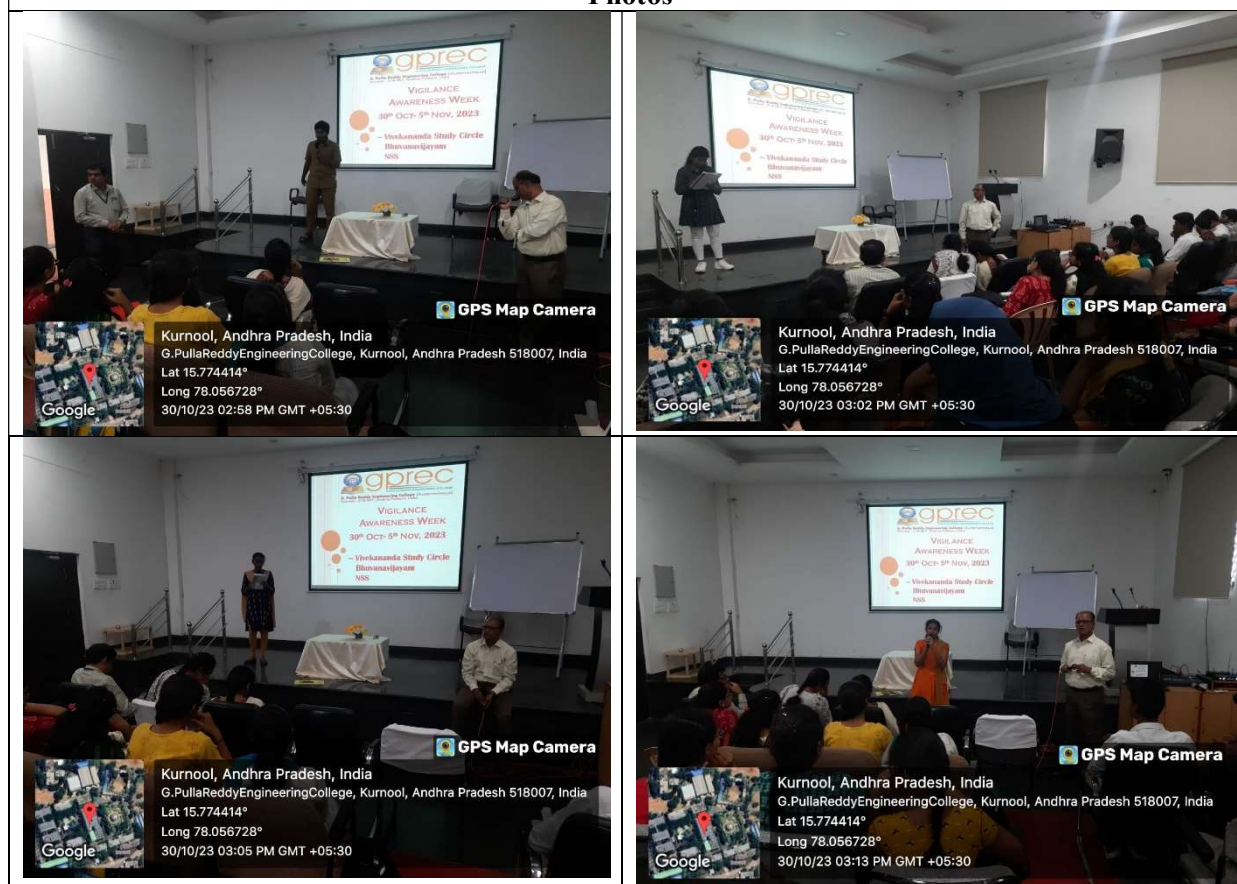

Outcome:	Students understood the necessity of following the principles of honesty and ethical practice for wellbeing of society.

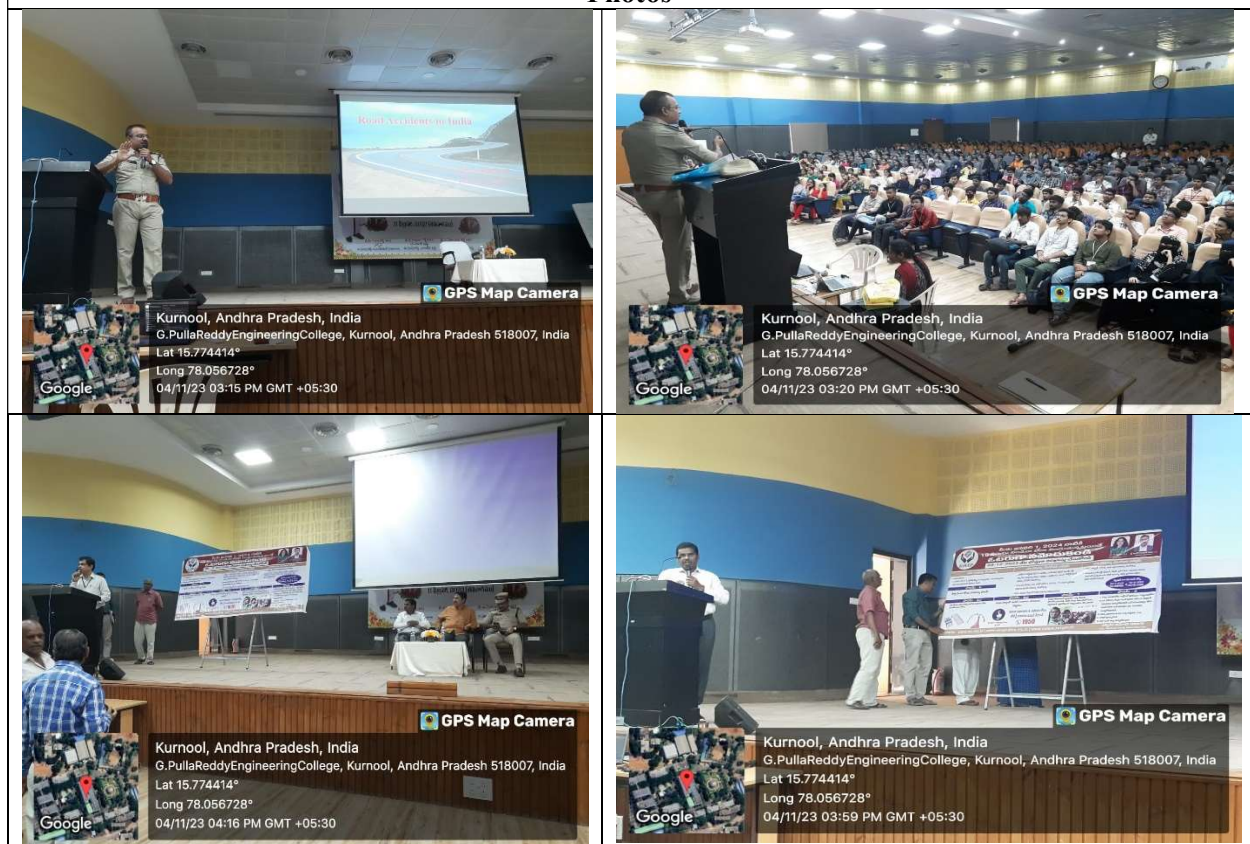

Outcome:	Students became aware of various mechanisms and understood the necessity to be strong and empowered to promote a safe and respectful work environment.

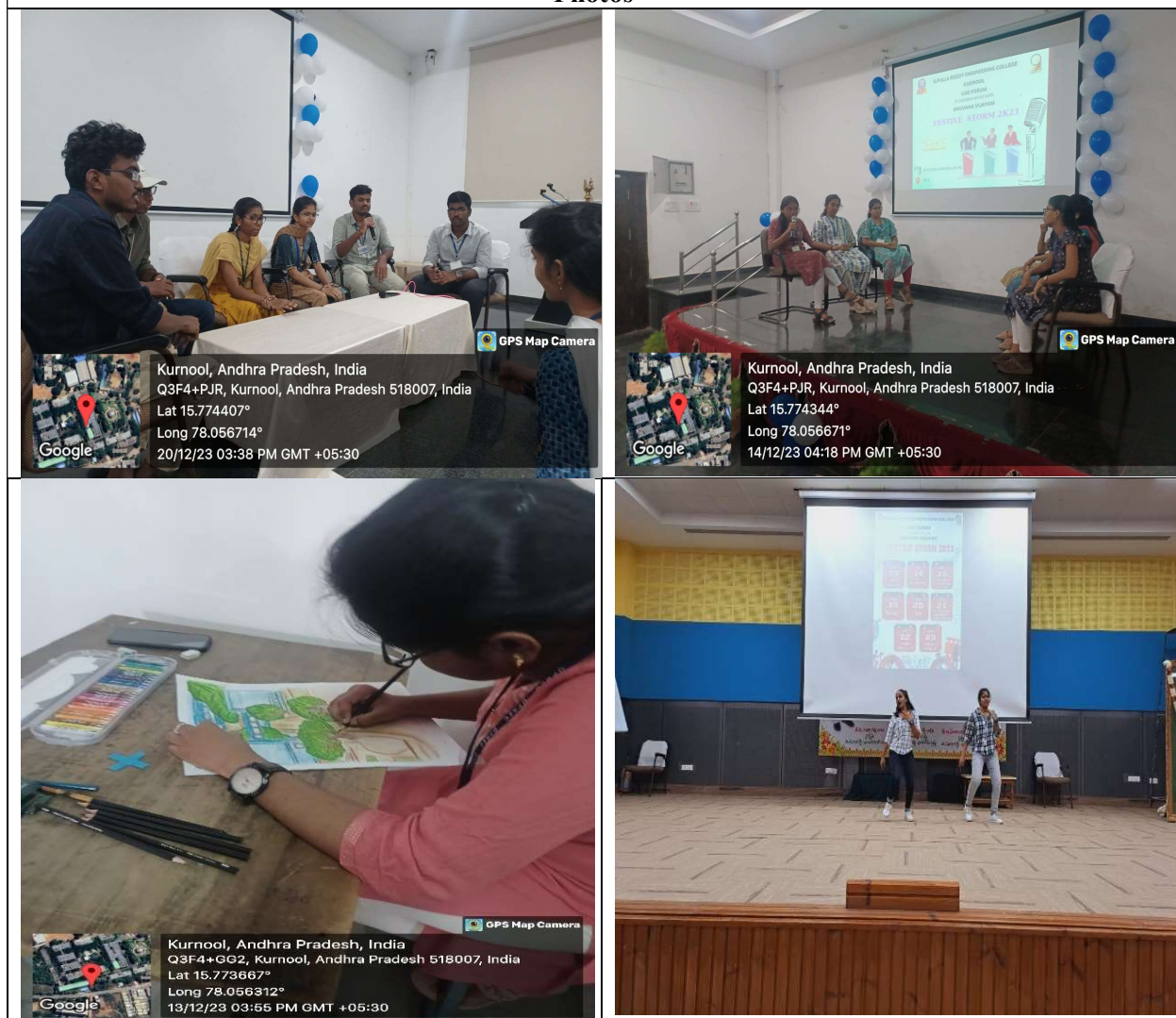
