2. As part of Nationwide protest against R G Kar Medical College, Kolkata incident, Bhuvanavijayam Forum (BV) in association with other forums of EAA cell, organized a solidarity march and Rasta Roko on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2024. Number of students present was around 300.
3. An Awareness Programme on Save Hundri and K.C. Canal was organized by Bhuvanavijayam, in association with other forums of EAA cell on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2024. Number of students participated was around 180.
4. Bhuvanavijayam organized Rangoli Competition and cultural programs on the occasion of Ganesh Chaturdhi celebrations on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2024. Total number of participants were 60.
5. NSS and Bhuvanavijayam combinedly organized Clean Campus program on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. Number of students participated were around 150.
