Observations:




1. Student feed-back is being taken and shared with faculty to improve academic quality.
2. The amount of course covered is monitored from time to time through meetings at the various levels.
3. Based on the suggestions of the department advisory committee / academic council new courses have been started at the UG & PG.
4. Revision of the existing programmes is done by receiving feed-back from various stake holders and also informal interactions with the members of different sections of the society
5. A Grievance Committee has been functioning well to look after various student issues.
6. e-books and research journals are made available through INFLIBNET
7. Ramps have been placed for ease of use for differently abled people and adequate access to computer and other facilities have been included at ground floors of libraries/offices.
8. Teachers are making extensive use of smart boards and power point presentations.

Suggestions

1. Faculty improvement programme should be strengthened
2. Career guidance and placement initiatives may be strengthened
3. Management may think of providing hostel facility to boys
4. Faculty may be encouraged to publish their research work in referred journals
5. The Faculty need to be further enthused to take up research activities through applying for Minor and Major Projects funded by UGC and other governmental and nongovernmental agencies

The college may consider making use of the various schemes provided by UGC and other Government departments for enhancement of college infrastructure and promotion of faculty development, research, publication and extension activities. It may also consider developing linkages with local industries, research institutions and other agencies so as to provide on the job learning opportunities both for the students and the faculty. The institution may encourage the young talented faculty to undertake consultancy.
