1. As the IQAC coordinator Dr S. Govindarajulu, Professor of ECE has been relieved from the services, Director informed that Dr R Praveen Sam, Professor of CSE & Convener of P&E cell has been nominated as the Coordinator of IQAC from the Academic Year 2019-20. He informed that the IQAC committee has been reconstituted and read the names of all committee members. He read out the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
2. Members are informed that a course on Life Sciences shall be included in the next revision of curriculum.
3. Principal informed the HODs to submit the information of their respective department's assessment to the IQAC cell for the preparation of AQAR 2018-19.
4. Principal informed the members that keeping in view the Counselling process by APSCH for admissions into I B.Tech Engineering programme, the Orientation Programme for First B.Tech students admitted in the Academic year 2019-20 shall be organized on 17th August 2019 followed by Two Week Student Induction Programme.
5. Members discussed at length and finalized that the evaluation of Minor Degree Courses shall be completely faculty centric. Faculty shall allot and evaluate students performance as follows
  - a) 40 marks for Internal marks by conducting Assignments, Quizzes & Tests.
  - b) 20 marks for Practicals or for model preparation
  - c) 40 marks for End Examination.





	have published at least one research paper in Scopus / UGC listed journals. A total of 286 papers have been published in Scopus / UGC listed journals.

As per the guidelines issued by funding agencies from time to time, adequate number of proposals has been submitted to various agencies like AICTE, UGC, DST etc. 10 Proposals to AICTE and one to UGC have been submitted out of which, four have been sanctioned by AICTE
To arrange Technical tours for III B.Tech students.	Technical tours for III B.Tech EEE & CE students were arranged. Students are exposed to latest technological developments in real time environment.
To apply for renewal of fourth cycle of NBA accreditation for ECE and CSE branches in 2018-19.	NBA expert committee visited the College and accredited both UG programmes namely ECE and CSE programmes.
To improve the consultancy services in 2018-19.	Improvement in terms of number of clients, revenue has been observed. Number of Clients has been increased from 212 to 234 and the revenue generated increased from 12.24L to 13.79L.
